



# Registered Psychologist or Registered Clinical Social Worker

**Saffron Sexual Assault Centre in Sherwood Park is looking for a compassionate and skilled Registered Psychologist or Registered Clinical Social worker to join our counselling team!**

Saffron Centre is a non-profit charitable organization offering counselling services to survivors of sexual trauma. Saffron offers therapists the opportunity to provide quality counselling services through insurance or on a sliding fee scale to clients who may not be able to afford trauma-informed counselling.

## **Qualifications and Requirements:**

- Must be currently covered under the Health Professions Act with either a Registered Psychologist (R Psych) or Clinical Social Worker (CSW) designation and hold registration in good standing with their licensing body.
- Knowledge, and skills in counselling adult, teen, and/ or child (4 years and up) survivors of sexual violence. Training and experience using mind-body therapies is an asset to this position (e.g. Mindfulness, MBSR, SRT, Hakomi, DBT, Somatic Experiencing, EMDR, etc.). Psychologists and Clinical Social Workers with training in using Play Therapy or expressive arts with traumatized clients are also encouraged to apply.
- Must have a passion for providing accessible, quality, trauma-informed counselling in an environment of diversity and inclusion.
- Registration (or eligible to be registered) as a Mental Health provider with First Nations and Inuit Health Branch are a requirement for this position.
- Satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Criminal Record check, Children's Services Intervention Record check, and professional liability insurance are all required.
- Proof of full vaccination of COVID-19

## **What we offer:**

- Our therapy, public education, police & court support, and administrative teams are unified in treating clients and each other with kindness, respect, integrity, and responsibility, in an environment mindful of privilege, micro-aggression, and valuing holistic services.
- We value - and share! - a sense of camaraderie; we don't just work beside each other, but as respected colleagues and resources for each other. The counselling team meets monthly to share skills and ideas; and collaboration between therapists is encouraged.
- This contract therapist position offers the flexibility of days, evenings and Saturdays; we are asking for a commitment of between 5-25 hours per week. This may include a blend of both telehealth and in-person therapy.
- Professional Development funds may be made available to contract therapists subject to funding.
- With a minimum commitment of 20 hours per week, this position may be eligible for enrollment in the Group Benefit Plan.
- Opportunities for FUN are infused in our work culture including workshops, fundraisers, team-building, staff-pamper days, and parties.
